DIRECTIONS:

From the South, take I-75 and exit at SR 52. Go West on SR 52 to US 41 and make a right (North) on US 41. Go approximately 5.5 miles and make a left at Field Event sign in front of the gate. (Nearest mail box to gate is at 16354 US 41.) Follow Dog Grounds and Field Event signs approximately 1 mile into the property to the main camp site.

From the North, take I-75 and exit SR 50. Go West on SR 50 to US 41. Go South on US 41 approximately 11 miles and turn right at the Field Event sign in front of the gate. (Nearest mail box to gate is at 16354 US 41.) Follow Dog Grounds and Field Event signs approximately 1 mile into the property to the main camp site.

The grounds will be open for the weekend about 3 pm Friday before the event.

CAMPING:

Camping is allowed on the Masaryktown Field Grounds. No electric hookups are available. Water is available on the grounds. An outdoor hot water shower is available.

➤ Al Luther has space for anyone who may want to camp with dogs. Stalls, hot showers, and full hook ups available. Call Al Luther (352) 799-0979 (1/4 mile north of the grounds on US 41).

BREAKFAST: Coffee and doughnuts will be furnished by the club each morning.

LUNCH: Lunch will be available both days free with each entry, all others \$4.00.

DINNER: A "pitch in" dinner will be held on Saturday night. Bring a covered dish to share and the meat of your choice to grill for yourself. We will build a fire and have space available on the grill.

Excessive drinking will not be tolerated. Please do not drink and drive.

If your dogs, horses, other family members, or guests dig holes, you are expected to refill them before you leave. You are expected to pick up around your camp or park site. This includes spreading out horse poop and leftover hay. Please do not put trash on the ground; proper trash containers are available.

If you cook out on your own, be sure to keep your fire under control. Be sure your fire is completely out when you leave and your fire pit is completely covered. Safety comes first.

Please respect your fellow campers and keep noise to a minimum at night. Others may have to be up very early the next morning to participate in the event. The Masaryktown Field Ground is part of a working cattle ranch. Keep motor vehicles on the obvious roadways. Keep motor vehicles out of any muddy area. Do not drive across our fields.

For the purpose of determining misconduct during an AKC Licensed Event, the event is not considered over until all participants have left the grounds and the gate is locked.

COURSES & BIRDS

All tests will be a single course with a bird field. Native and liberated quail will be used in all tests. Only blank pistols (starter pistols) may be used in Junior Hunter Tests. All live shooting will be done by Official Gunners. Breaking shotguns only are allowed on the Masaryktown property during field events. Horseback handling IS NOT permitted in any test. Tracking devices approved by the AKC will be allowed.

PRIZES

Standard AKC rosettes to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

REFUNDS

No entry fees will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
